And that is why we call him Polka Dot!

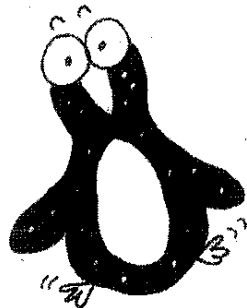

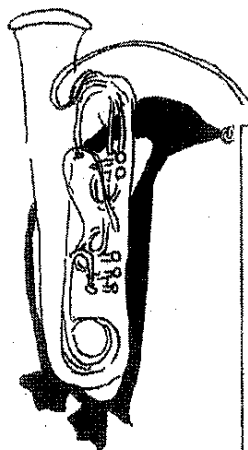
